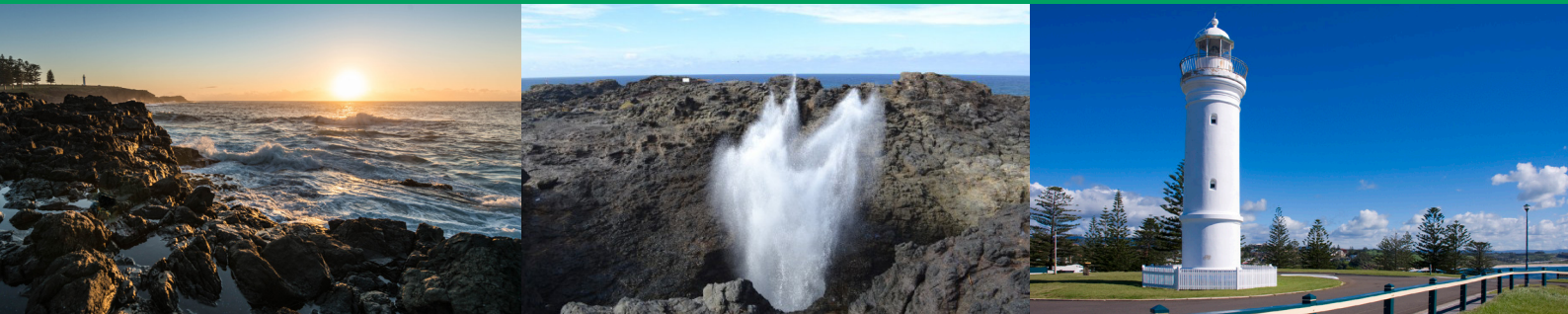


NSW FALLS PREVENTION NETWORK RURAL FORUM
