

Priority Setting Partnership (PSP)

 PSP = bringing patients, carers and clinicians together to identify and prioritise unanswered questions in specific conditions or areas of healthcare, for research, using James Lind Alliance methods.







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James Lind Alliance (JLA) method

- Step 1: Develop collaboration with interest-holders
- Step 2: Identify, summarise, and rank the most important priorities and gaps
- Step 3: Develop a strategic research agenda to address these gaps
